
## History

- Amino acid found in pumpkin seeds
- First isolated in 1961
- In Chinese medicine, dried ripe pumpkin seeds were used to treat schistosomiasis (snail fever)

## **Application**




As part of pumpkin seeds, cucurbitin has shown the ability to kill roundworms in chickens

Latin Cucurbita = pumpkin
Chemical name

(3*R*)-3-aminopyrrolidine-3-carboxylic acid
